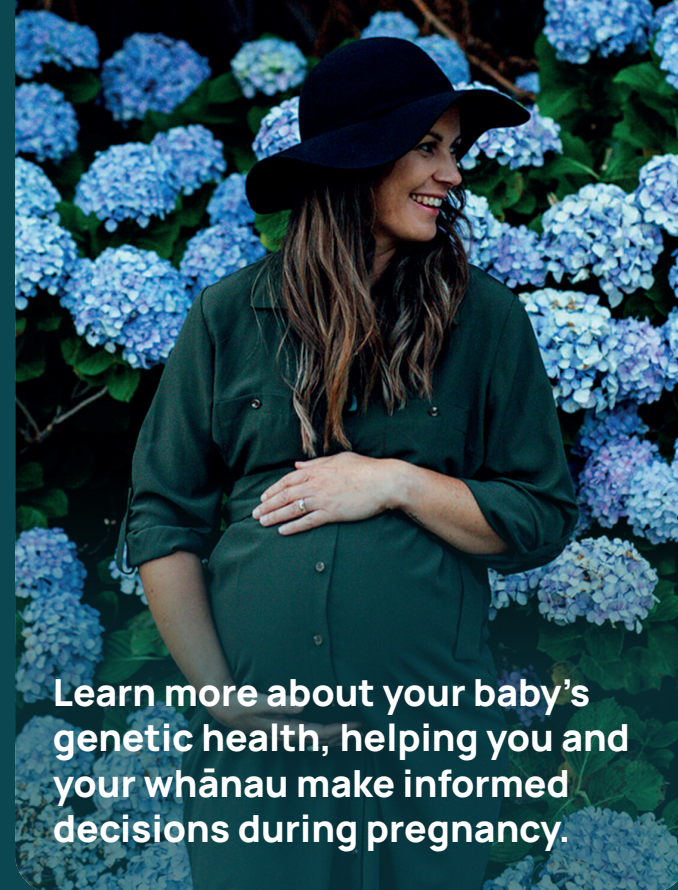

About Illumiscreen

A simple blood test that provides information to support discussions and decision-making with your healthcare provider and whānau.

It analyses cell-free DNA from the placenta that is naturally present in your bloodstream.

Conditions screened:

- Down syndrome (Trisomy 21)
- Edwards syndrome (Trisomy 18)
- Patau syndrome (Trisomy 13)
- Sex chromosome differences (e.g. Turner syndrome)
- Selected rare chromosomal conditions

You can also choose to learn your baby's sex.



How it works:



Order your test online at illumiscreen.co.nz



Complete a referral form with your healthcare provider (midwife, GP, or lead maternity carer)



Have a blood test at an Awanui Labs Collection Centre (your local centre may offer pre-booking – check online)



Your sample is analysed at our Auckland laboratory



Results are sent to your healthcare provider (usually within 5–7 working days)

Test collection locations

You can have your blood collected at one of 150+ Awanui Labs collection centres across New Zealand.

Understanding your results

Illumiscreen is a screening test, not a diagnosis.

It indicates whether there is a higher or lower chance of a chromosomal condition.

Your healthcare provider can help you and your whānau understand the results and discuss any next steps.

Support from genetic counsellors

Genetic counsellors are available to assist healthcare providers and patients in:

- Understanding high risk screening results
- Discussing potential outcomes
- Supporting decision-making about further testing
- Providing guidance around pregnancy management

Local collection options

If there isn't an Awanui Labs Collection Centre in your area, you can still access Illumiscreen.

We'll send you a blood collection kit, along with prepaid packaging to return your sample. Once your blood sample has been collected locally, just send it back to our Auckland laboratory using the prepaid return pack.
